### Submission Criteria:

- Movies need to be on DVD, or removable media
- Participants can enter the competition individually or as part of a group.
- Your movie will need to be of appropriate taste and decency and must not contain defamatory or obscene material. Movies that may cause offence or encourage breaking the law are also difficult for us to show.
- You'll need written permission for people, imagery and music featured in your movie – unless it has been created by you. If you do include uncleared/copyright material, then we will not be able to use or broadcast your film.
- No entries will be accepted from Young Motion Plymouth employees and their families.
- All suitable movies will be selected for submission to the South West Film and Television Archive following the contest.
- The closing date for entries is **1st October 2011**
- The Judges' decision is final.

**Due to the number of entries, we cannot guarantee that we can show all of the movies.**
